Guidelines:

A good letter of recommendation should provide an accurate assessment of the applicant's suitability for an undergraduate degree program at Northeast Maritime Institute. A good letter of recommendation *must* contain the following elements:

- Briefly explain your relationship with the applicant
- Length of time you have known the applicant
- Your observation of the applicant's academic, professional and/or personal traits

Please address some or all of the following elements:

- Work Ethic
- Unique or Remarkable Personality Qualities
- o Noteworthy Level of Knowledge in Specific Areas
- Maturity Level and Ethical Responsibility: Does the applicant behave in an honest and ethical manner? Are they reliable in personal, academic and/or professional obligations?
- o Insight into Applicant's Perspective of their World/Future
- Capacity for Improvement: How does the applicant receive instruction/correction? Are they comfortable asking for directions/assistance when needed?
- o **Suitability for the Program**: Does the applicant display academic and technical competence/knowledge to succeed at a maritime school?
- **Teamwork**: Does the applicant possess the ability and willingness to work in groups/teams?
- Task Completion: Does the applicant complete tasks in a timely manner? Are they flexible in their ways of thinking?
